The poultry production in the county is decreasing to help solve the feed problem. Plans are being made for producing feed at home. The poultry demonstrators, women and girls, were visited this month for getting ready for the Spring baby chicks that they will soon be buying. Plans were made for securing brooder facilities for those who did not have brooders and those who have brooders already on hand are to be cleaned and sterilized. The stock chickens are to be bought in February or early March.

The high price of feed is the problem every farm wife is bringing to the agent. It was suggested that each farm family produce just enough poultry and eggs to supply the family needs, and enough fryers to supply the family need annually. The plan was made with each poultry demonstrator.

Two poultry demonstrators, Mrs. L. V. Williams of Hempstead community and Mrs. Claudia Tompkins of Laneview community are planning to raise poultry for the market. Mrs. Williams has 165 pullets coming into production and Mrs. Tompkins has 50 pullets coming into production. They plan to have trap nests and increase the egg production each year.

One of the major demonstrations for 1948 is Garden Production.

A method demonstration was given on Making a Hot Bed to six community clubs this month. Many of the families in the county bought plants in former years and emphasis was stressed on increasing home grown plants. Those who didn't want to make a large permanent hot bed are using boxes for growing their plants using the same principles as the larger beds.

Home visits were made for enrolling 1948 garden demonstrators.

Mrs. Leola Johnson of Center Hill community, Mrs. Lucretia Gooden of Lewisville community, Mrs. Clara Williams and Mrs. Rosa Lark of Sunnyside community, Mrs. Effie West of Wyatt Chapel community, Mrs. L. V. Williams and Mrs. Maggie Moore of Hempstead community, Mrs. Saphronia Blackshear of Brookshire community enrolled as garden demonstrators for 1948. They will carry out the principles and practices recommended by the Extension Service to grow, can, prepare and store vegetables for family use.

Approximately 70 farmers have agreed to grow cucumbers for a Pickling Company in Houston, Texas. This is an added cash crop for farmers in the county and they will grow cucumbers as recommended by the Extension Service assisted by the County Agents.
