The home and Agricultural agents worked together in giving method demonstrations on dressing and drawing turkeys for home use and market. The turkeys that was used in the food preparation demonstrations were used in the demonstrations on dressing and drawing turkeys. The communities in which the demonstrations were held furnished the turkey for the demonstration.

The scalding method was used instead of the dry picking method and a very luscious looking bird resulted.

9000 turkeys were sold in the Christmas market and 1000 stayed on the farms for reproduction.
