A MESSEGE TO TEACHERS

OBSERVANCE OF UNITED NATIONS DAY IN SCHOOLS 24 October 1950

The General Assembly of the United Nations, at its Second Session, passed a Resolution declaring that 24 October, the anniversary of the coming into force of the Charter of the United Nations, should henceforth be called "United Nations Day" and be devoted to making known to the peoples of the world the sims and achievements of the United Nations. The Resolution invited all Member Governments to cooperate in securing observance of the Day.

The spirit of this year's observance is embodied in the theme "THERE S HALL BE PIACE" as reaffirmation by the people of their determination that the aims expressed in the United Nations Charter shall be achieved.

Last year, schools in forty-four countries joined in ceremonial observances. In one country, pupils in national costumes staged United "ations pageants. In another, schools observed one minute of silent prayer. Elsewhere there were salutes to the United Nations Flag, essay competitions, poster displays and special plays honoring the Organization.

Booklets were printed for guidance of pupils and teachers, Schools were assembled to hear special broadscats. In several countries there were United Nations film showings and parties for four-year-old children, since the United Nations itself was four years old. In memy countries - which was specially encouraging - students wrote letters to the United Nations expressing their hope and faith in this world organ of peace and planning for better living for all mankind.

The main purpose, however is to use the observance either as a culmination of special studies on the United Nations, or as the starting point for further studies.

This message is to invite teachers throughout the world to observe the Day in 1950 and to use it as an appeal for faith and reasoned support. The Secretary-General, as the Chief Executive of the United Nations, has written the enclosed message to young people of all member States. It might be read aloud to the school assembly and discussed in the classrooms. In addition, pupils might make copies to discuss in their homes.

Some Suggested Activities for Celebrating UNITED NATIONS DAY:

- 1. Posters for display in schools, libraries and store windows might be prepared in art classes.
- 2. Assembly programs might include unfurling the UN flag, a silent prayer for peace through the UN, a reading of the Secretary-General's letter, a short address, the showing of a United Nations film and suitable songs.
- 3. Class teachers might plan special classroom activities for this day. For younger pupils these might include games such as identifying the countries and flags of member nations, exhibitions of articles from other countries, letters to pen friends, and stories and songs from other lands.

Purpose: To emphasize the high hope for peace for which the United Nations flag stands.

Meaning of the flag: The blue of the flag is a brave color; the olive branches of peace and the entire inhabited world symbolize peace for the entire world.

The flag is a proud symbol of democratic life; it speaks its belief in the unit and goodness of a free mankind - - it shouts its encouraging message of strength in the frame work of a union of nations who want to safe guard the rights of men.

Pledges to th flags

To the United States Flag:

"I pledge allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and to the Republic for which it stands, one Nation indivisible, with liberty and justic for all"

To the United Nations Flag:

"As a loyal 4-H citizen of the United States, I pledge my full support to the United Nations, The one great hope for a peaceful world, with freedom and safety for all."

How to display the United Nations Falg:

The United Nations Flag may be displayed alone. When flown with the United States Flag the United Nations Falg should be flown at the same height and be of approximately equal size. It should never be carried flat or horizontally but always aloft and free. It should never be used as a drapery of any sort, never festooned, drawn back or up in folds, but always allowed to fall free. It should normally only be displayed on buildings and flagstaffs from sunrise to sunset. It should not be displayed on days when the weather is inclement.
